3. In Isaiah 42:8-9 what does God declare to be part of his glory? Why is this important?
4. Why is Jesus' statement in John 13:19 significant? Why do think verse John 13:20 finishes with the words "I am he"?
5. What is the burden of foreknowledge? (see John 6:64) Do you think Jesus knew these things because he was God, or was he told them by the Father through the Spirit? Give reasons for and against?
6. How can God be confident He knows the future? (See Jeremiah 1:12 and Ezekiel 12:25) What implications does this have for us and how we live our lives?
