QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. With reference to **John 12:12-13** and **Revelation 7:9-10**, explore the connection between our Christian walk here on earth and our focus on heavenly realities as we reach out to the world around us.
2. Discuss what Jesus was focused on as he moved towards his death on the cross.
3. Examine the fact that it is not Jesus' suffering as such that brings us Life, but the fact that He dealt with the reality of death.
4. Reflect on how our own journey to being a disciple of Jesus reflects His journey from entering into Jerusalem through to the resurrection.

Reading: Luke 9: 51-62

Isaiah 50:7 Because the Sovereign Lord helps me, I will not be disgraced. Therefore have I set my face like flint, and I know I will not be put to shame.

BIBLE REFERENCES CONTINUED

Matthew 16:24-25 Then Jesus said to his disciples, “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it.

Luke 12:50 But I have a baptism to undergo, and what constraint I am under until it is completed!

Mark 10:38 “You don’t know what you are asking,” Jesus said. “Can you drink the cup I drink or be baptized with the baptism I am baptized with?”

Romans 6:3-14 Or don’t you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his.

Revelation 7:9-10 After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands. And they cried out in a loud voice: “Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb.”
