QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

1. What do you do to relieve stress & worry in your life?
2. How does what you think about affect how you feel? How does it affect your relationship with God?
3. What are the main causes of worry in your life at the moment?
4. Paul's desire was to know & experience Christ (3:10), how could this knowledge & experience of Christ help you with the things you are worrying about?
5. What is Paul's antidote to anxiousness?
6. As we move further into the Omicron outbreak how can this passage guide you?
7. Discuss what this statement could look like in your life: 'Saturate our minds thoroughly year after year by selecting our thoughts scrupulously moment by moment.'

Reading: Philippians 4: 2 - 9

Philippians 3:10-11 I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead.

BIBLE REFERENCES CONTINUED

Romans 12:1-2 Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Colossians 3:15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace.

Romans 13:14 Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
