BIBLE REFERENCES

Reading: Psalm 46

1 John 4:10 This is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

Ephesians 1:7-8 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that he lavished on us.

Romans 5:9 Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!
