
Questions for reflection

1. When you think of God's "mercies", what comes to mind? How have you experienced God's mercy in your life? What response or action should arise in us from considering the mercies of God?
2. How would you define the term sacrifice? What role did sacrifice have in the Old Testament? What place does sacrifice have in society today?
3. How can we be a living sacrifice? If Christ is the final sacrifice for our sin (Hebrews 10:12), why does Paul urge us to present our bodies as a "living sacrifice"? What is it a sacrifice for?
4. If our bodies are sinful, how can we offer them as a holy and acceptable living sacrifice to God?
5. How do we generally define "worship" today? What things often get omitted from worship in churches today? Why can't music by itself be the origin of worship? Why does Paul link the way we live our lives and what we sacrifice back to our worship?
6. Can there be true worship without sacrifice on our part? Discuss. What would worshipful sacrifice look like in your life?
