SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS - DANIEL 9: 22 - 27

1. What weight do you place on prophecy in the Bible? What piece of prophecy has strengthened your faith the most? Explain.
2. What six things does Gabriel say will be accomplished for Israel & Jerusalem within seventy "sevens" (often interpreted as 490 years). Which of these were accomplished when the Jewish people returned to Jerusalem from Babylon?
3. Which of the six do you see as the most significant? Who do you think the Anointed One is & why? Are there any of the six that are not yet fully accomplished? Explain.
4. Verse 26 says that "the people of the ruler who will come, will destroy the city & the sanctuary." The Romans destroyed Jerusalem & the temple in A.D. 70. How would you describe the course of events during the final period of seven years (vv26-27)?
5. Some Christians think the final "seven" was fulfilled in the time of Jerusalem's destruction by the Romans. Other Christians think the final seven years is still in the future & that this evil ruler will make his appearance on the world scene at that time. How do you react to the possibility of a wicked world ruler arising in our generation?
6. Does anything Gabriel says in verse 27 connect back to Daniel's vision in Chapter 8? If so, explain what it is & why that might be significant.
