2. Why do you think King Nebuchadnezzar turned to the ineffective "wise" men again? Why didn't he turn to Daniel sooner? What can we learn from this? Why do people not want to turn to God/Church/Believers more?
3. Why do you think Daniel turned pale when he was asked to interpret the dream? What does this show about his relationship to King Nebuchadnezzar? Does verse 22 remind you of any other prophetic condemnations (i.e. Nathan against David)?
4. What principle does this chapter teach about pride & God's sovereignty? Have you ever experienced God humbling you when you were prideful?
5. What advice did Daniel have for King Nebuchadnezzar? Did he listen?
6. What event immediately brought God's punishment down? Is this a common problem for rich/powerful people? What about poor & ordinary people?
7. How can we apply the lessons King Nebuchadnezzar learned, to our lives?
